## SUMMARY

He was only 18 years old when he was sentenced to death for an attack and the subsequent killing of 3 Britishers in Muzaffarpur, Bihar in 1908.

## EARLY LIFE

1889

- Born in Midnapore District of Bengal, he was son of a Tehsildar.
- Life was difficult as he lost both his parents by age of 7 and was cared for by his elder sister.

## JOINING INDEPENDENCE STRUGGLE

1904

- Volunteered to be part of revolutionary activities against the British at age of 15
- Joined Anushilan Samiti, a Bengali organization famous for using revolutionary ideas to drive British out of India.

## MARTYRDOM

1908

- An assassination was planned against Chief Magistrate Douglas H Kingsford who was infamous for harsh punishments to freedom fighters.
- Khudiram along with Prafulla Chaki planned to bomb the car of Kingsford. However Kingsford was in a different carriage and the bomb killed 2 other British women.
- After the incident, Khudiram was arrested and put to trial.
- As the Judge read out the sentence of death by hanging, Khudiram smiled. He went to the gallows and laid down his life at tender age of 18 for our nation.
