SUMMARY

Bengali revolutionary associated with the Jugantar group of revolutionaries who carried out assassinations against British colonial officials in an attempt to secure Indian independence.

He was just 19 years old when he sacrificed his life for the Nation

EARLY LIFE

1888

- Born on 10 December 1888 in the Bihari village of Bogra district, now Bangladesh
- Expelled from Rangpur Zilla School when studying in Class 9 for taking part in a students' demonstration
- Joined Rangpur National School where he came in contact with revolutionaries and became a believer and practitioner of the revolutionary philosophies

REVOLUTIONARY ACTIVITIES

1905

- First assignment was to kill Joseph Bampfylde Fuller the first Lieutenant Governor of the new province of Eastern Bengal. But, the plan did not materialize
- Prafulla and Khudiram Bose chosen for the assassination of Kingsford, the magistrate of Muzaffarpur, Bihar who was unpopular for passing harsh and cruel sentences on young political workers of Bengal
- Bomb was thrown into the carriage but there was a mistake of identification and the vehicle was not carrying Kingsford but his wife and daughter

MARTYDOM

1908

- Escaped via travel in a train compartment, but Nandalal Banerjee, a police officer arrested him.
- But Prafulla committed suicide with his own revolver
