22 Mar 1894 – 12 Jan 1934  
His revolution gave rise to several freedom fighters in Bengal. He was the man behind Chittagong Armoury Raid (also known as 'Chittagong Uprising') and had 64 revolutionaries along with him. During the Raid, they captured the city and hoisted the Indian national flag declaring Gandhi Raj. He was later captured, brutally tortured and hanged.

## EARLY LIFE

1884-1924

- Born in Chittagong, son of a School teacher
- When doing B.A course, got attracted towards revolutionary ideals.
- At Age 24, became a Mathematics Teacher.

## CHITTAGONG UPRISING

1930

- Organized Raid on Chittagong British Police Armory along with group of 64 young revolutionaries.
- Succeeded in disrupting communication lines and Train Movements
- He hosted the National Flag in Police station, declared Provisional Revolutionary Government before being pushed back to hills by British Troops.

## TRIAL AND MARTYRDOM

1934

- Evaded Arrest for 3 years before getting captured.
- Arrested, subjected to in-human torture –British broke all his teeth and joints before hanging.
- Source of inspiration for many Bengali Youth to join Freedom Struggle.
